### Online giving is now available.

Your support of Mount Calvary is always appreciated, and you may now give on-line if you desire. Here is how it works:

- >Go to www.mt-calvarylutheran.org.
- >On the bottom right of the home page click the "donate" button.
- >You will be taken to a secure PayPal page. (You do not need a PayPal account.)
- >Enter the amount of your donation and your credit or debit card information.



Your donations will be listed on your annual giving statement. All undesignated contributions will go into the General Fund. You can, however, make a contribution to a special cause like the Stepping Forward in Faith Appeal by entering the information in the "purpose" box on the webpage. If you desire, you can also make your offering an automatic monthly contribution.

### **BLESSING 2025**

If you come through my front door and then turn around facing the door, look up. There you will see a yellow Post-It note, and on it this message: 20+CMB+24. What is this mysterious message and why do I have it posted over my front door?

I began putting a sign on the inside framework of my front door several years ago, when I started using the Augsburg Fortress (our ELCA printing house) devotional for Advent/Christmas/Epiphany. Included in the Epiphany portion of the devotional is a contemporization of an Eastern European tradition of inscribing a visual blessing above the main door of the family dwelling. White chalk is the suggested medium, but white chalk did not work on my varnished door framework. Instead I taped a Post-It note on the framework. But what do the numbers and letters mean?

The numbers refer to the current year. Next year they will change to 20 and 25. The letters CMB can have two different meanings. They can stand for the ancient Latin blessing "Christe mansionem benedicat" (translated "Christ bless this house.") Or they can stand for the legendary names given to the magi who visited the Christ child in a house: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. (Matthew 2:11)

This year I will change the note to read 20+CMB+25 sometime around January 6, the Epiphany of our Lord. And I will use this prayer from this year's devotional:

#### O God,

you revealed your Son to all people by the shining light of a star.


We (I) pray that you bless this house and all who live here with your gracious presence.

May your love be our inspiration, your wisdom our guide, your truth our light, and your peace our benediction; through Christ our Lord. Amen.

I like having this blessing over my front door. It's not magic, but rather a continual prayer over my home.


The annual Congregational Meeting to approve the budget and election of council members will be held January 26<sup>th</sup> following worship.


